 Guidelines and Rules
 (* no rain date)

- Vessels must be constructed using ONLY cardboard and duct tape
- Children under the age of 9 may only participate if a parent or legal guardian is in the vessel with them.
- Disqualification will occur if boats are found to have any paint, wax, or any other water proofing agents applied. Extremely seaworthy crafts may be inspected for illegal materials (chain saws could be involved) or asked to paddle to Beaverton.
- Boat must be self propelled using oars of any kind. i.e. wood, plastic, boards, etc.
- Single member or crewed entries are allowed
- All contestants under the age of 18 years of age must have a parent or guardian sign a registration form.
- Entries allowed in multiple divisions as long as your boat floats.
- There is NO RAIN DATE
- All entrants must ensure that their portion of the pit area has been cleaned prior to departure on Regatta day. All boats must be removed from the park.
- No boat will be allowed to leave the starting gate unless all persons on board are wearing a USCG approved Personal Flotation Device. (Participants will provide their own PFDs and paddles.)
- Only corrugated cardboard may be used. It can be of any thickness but must not be bonded to any other material such as vinyl. Non-corrugated materials may not be used, especially the kind of resin or wax-type coating found in packing cases. No solid cardboard and no carpet roll tubes may be used to strengthen the hull or boat structure.
- Judges reserve the right to amend rules for clarification or safety purposes.
